**WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION:** Want to paint vibrant watercolors that sing with color and sizzle with energy? Peggy shares her ink resist technique, helping artists to create luminous paintings. Along with the ink resist method, emphasis is placed on design, composition and the effective use of color. Students of all ability levels will have fun and be inspired with lots of individual instruction, guidance and supportive critiques. Peggy has taught numerous workshops and is regarded as an effective and enjoyable teacher. She is a signature member of the National Watercolor Society, the Rocky Mountain National Watermedia Society, Western Federation of Watercolor Societies and the Colorado Watercolor Society.

Materials List: Watercolor paper- Arches 140 paper in cold press or Quiller Watercolor, 140 lb. cold press (made by Jack Richeson and Co., available at [DickBlick.com](http://DickBlick.com)). We will be working on smaller size paintings so bring a few 15" x 22" or smaller sheets of paper.

**Watercolors**-general assortment of colors, I will be using Quiller brand, made by Jack Richeson and Co. Call if you have questions about your colors.

**Palette**- a plastic palette for your paints

**Brushes**- Suggested sizes: Flats size 1" 1/2" 1/4" 1/8", Rounds size 8, 4, and 2

Misc. pencil, eraser, ruler, scissors, masking tape, paper towels

**Subjects to paint:** pictures with strong contrast, dark shadows, and lots of color work well. I will bring some of my reference photos to share.

**Small containers**- please bring two containers, one small one with a lid for holding tempera paint and one larger one for water. Old plastic margarine containers work well (bring the lids). I will provide the ink and the tempera paint that will be used for the resist.
