Colorado in 1973. He is married and has two grown children girl and boy. A lot of his work shows influences of the South West especially New Mexico. He does a lot of Navajo style weaving in addition to his artwork.

While he had art as a child he had a lot of design influences. When he was 30 he picked up a pencil and started to draw and he hasn't stopped. He is self-taught and started with pencil and then pen and ink. . . and on to Oil and Pastel. He has studied at the Art Student League of Denver. He participates in MAG rotating exhibits and is really proud of his Honorable Mention in the MAG member show of 2016.

He admires the work of Clark Hulings, Van Gogh, Jackson Pollack, Charles Reynolds and the Fauve Painters. He is Realistic but occasionally branches into the abstract. Back and forth between the detailed and the looser compositions. He likes the different expressions in Navajo style, while designing his own rugs. His Tip: Draw what you see in your Mind!
