She likes judging art shows and doing critiques locally and nationally to help other artists accomplish the Best Work. **SO** bring in one (or two if time permits) works that are finished or in progress, that you would like Nancy to take a look at and help you come to a solution or let you know that it is time to step back and know that it is finished and you've made it.

It is best to NOT have the work covered in glass, so that there is less glare from the lights but she'll deal with it



anyway.
