must be identified on the back with title,  
medium, artist's name, and phone. Works  
must be dry, framed (when applicable or  
have wrapped and painted edges with  
staples visible only on the back), and ready  
for hanging with screw-eyes and wire. NO  
SAWTOOTH OR CLIP HANGERS. Entries  
with chipped frames, broken glass, etc. will  
be disqualified.**

**MAG Cards will be filled out by the artist  
and displayed on the front of paintings.**

**SALES:** Works must be for sale and cannot be a  
piece of art shown in a previous MAG Member  
Show. Sales will be made through Lakewood  
Arts; sales tax will be included at the time of  
the sale. Commission on sold paintings 20% to  
Lakewood Arts. Artist will be notified of a sale.
