

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all members of Mountainside Art Guild & Arvada Fine Arts Guild

DATES: November 4-12, 2023 Hours: M-F 10-6 SAT 9-6 SUN 10-5

LOCATION: Echter's Greenhouse, 5150
Garrison (corner of Garrison & 52nd), Arvada

THEME: Florals, plants, vegetables, gardening, landscapes

ENTRIES: Each artist may submit up to 3 works. The show will not be juried for entry. All two-dimensional fine art, including photography & digital (no crafts; no prints made from an original) is acceptable. Work must not have been displayed in a previous Echter's Show and MUST be original work of artist.

SPECIFICATIONS: Maximum width 36". Large works must be framed in Plexiglass (20" x 24"). No resin covered art. Work may be framed or gallery-wrapped; gallery-wrapped work must have minimum depth of 1 ½" with painted edges; staples on back. All paintings must be properly wired on the back with picture wire and D-rings. NO SAWTOOTH OR CLIP HANGERS. Paintings with damage to the frame, matting, glass OR that do not meet the above specifications will not be hung. Please label the back of each piece of artwork with name, phone, title of work, medium, and price.

FEES: \$8.00 per work (checks payable to Mountainside Art Guild)

AWARDS: The following awards will be given: Awards sponsored by Echter's & Mountainside Art Guild

Best of Show: \$100 Echter's Gift Certificate Echter's Choice: \$50 Echter's Gift Certificate 8 Merit Awards: \$25 each (given by MAG)

SALES: Sales will be handled by Echter's staff; all sales will go through Mountainside Art Guild's books for processing and tax reporting. A 15% commission will be paid to Echter's and 5% to MAG. Sold works will stay in the exhibit until the close of the show.

Acrylic Landscape painting workshop -Scott Roberts

Supplies tools –paint, brushes, canvas, pallet, water, rags, easel, pencil, gloves, painting attire or apron

Paint I use Liquitex Basics for most of my work. You can use whatever paint you want.

The paint will be the costliest item. I would encourage artists to get together and share. One 4oz tube of each color will easily supply 6 to 8 artists for the workshop.

I can supply the paint for this workshop* \$7.50 per person (I'll purchase several tubes of each color to be shared during the workshop) Let him know!

(T- transparent, ST- semitransparent, O-opaque)

Ultramarine blue T

Alizarin Crimson ST

Indian Yellow T

(Indian yellow not made in Basics— use Liquitex professional Heavy body Acrylic OR Master's Touch Thick Body Acrylic (Hobby Lobby))

Titanium White O

Cerulean Blue O

Cadmium Red Medium O

Cadmium Yellow Medium or light O

At the minimum get Ultramarine blue, Alizarin Crimson, Indian Yellow, and Titanium White

I can supply the paint for this workshop \$7.50 (per person) I'll purchase several tubes of each color to be shared during the workshop, (please let Scott know if you are planning on doing this)

Brushes (do not use your good watercolor brushes) These are level one brushes, but feel free to upgrade if you want.

Acrylic brushes – Gold Taklon (or similar) 3/4" or 1 inch Flat

#6 round

Royal & Langnickel Essentials Brush Set, Bright Item #10415690 (get the one oil brush too)) OIL #6 filbert natural hair bristle brush- (#6 Simply Simmons Bristle Filbert Brush (Chungking hog bristles)

Canvas 5-11x14 (not paper) I prefer stretched canvas because of its texture.

No need to get expensive canvas for this workshop. I get the Value Packs of 7pc - 11x14 canvases Michaels or Hobby Lobby Scott can supply the canvas for this workshop* \$10.00 for 5-11x14 (please me know if you are planning on doing this)

Pallet- large enough to put out paints and an area for mixing. Several commercially made palettes Plastic or glass are available. A glass kitchen plate may be used.

I use Artist's Loft™ from Michaels 20 Well Rectangular Artist Palette Item # 10208003

Water-

Water container- to rinse, soak and wash out brushes. A coffee can works well - something that won't tip over easily with brushes in it.

Spray bottle – to mist palette and canvas buy one or use an old Windex bottle (or similar spray bottle) Multiple people share one. A bigger spray is better.

Rags or paper towels, or both – I mainly use rags old T–shirts, paper towels work good for wiping brushes and palette off. I recommend a rag (old T-shirt) because it doesn't break down and leave fuzz in the paint on the canvas.

Drawing tools- something to draw with - pencil, charcoal, charcoal white pencil.

Easel – this is Up to you.

Free

standing or **desk top** types work great. **You do not need an easel for this workshop**, but I feel it would be beneficial if you did.

Gloves – this is Up to you, mainly to keep hands clean (all 72 colors in the Liquitex Basics are non-toxic)

Clothing / Apron– Please wear appropriate attire for painting – Acrylic does not wash out easily even when wet.
