GENE YOUNGMANN

Colorado Watercolorist Gene Youngmann has been painting transparent watercolors since 1981 along the Front Range Mountains west of Denver. Youngmann's subject of choice is Colorado landscapes, vintage automobiles and aging architecture. He is a retired high school art teacher, having taught drawing for twenty-five years at Golden High School in Jefferson County Schools.

Youngmann holds six signature watercolor society memberships. He has been a signature member of the Colorado Watercolor Society (CWS) since 1991 and served as CWS President, 2005-2007, has served as the CWS Delegate to the Western Federation of Watercolor Societies (WFWS), and was the CWS Project Manager for the 41st Annual WFWS Exhibition during the summer of 2016 at the Arvada Center for the Arts and Humanities.

Youngmann is a plein air painter, painting 90 percent of his work on location during the warmer months and participating in plein air events yearly. His paintings are regularly displayed in International, National, Regional and Local exhibitions. His paintings are included in many private and corporate art collections, most recently the Colorado School of Mines President's Office in Golden, CO in 2013 and the Foothills Art Center in Golden, CO in 2016. Youngmann has created the past three poster designs for the Annual Historical Westminster Jazz and Art Fest held in June each year.

LOCATION: Echter's Greenhouse, 5150 Garrison
(corner of Garrison & 52nd), Arvada

THEME: Florals, plants, vegetables, gardening,
landscapes

ENTRIES: Each artist may submit up to 3 works.
The show will not be juried for entry. Works will
be accepted in the order registration forms are
received. Approximately 135 works will be hung.
All two-dimensional fine art, including
photography & digital (no crafts; no prints made
from an original), is acceptable. Work must not
have been displayed in a previous Echter's Show
and MUST be original work of artist.

SPECIFICATIONS: Maximum width 36". Large
works must be framed in Plexiglass. No resin
covered art. Work may be framed or gallery-
wrapped; gallery-wrapped work must have
minimum depth of 1 1/2" with painted edges;
staples on back. All paintings must be properly
wired on the back with picture wire and D-rings.
NO SAWTOOTH OR CLIP HANGERS. Paintings
with damage to the frame, matting, glass, OR that
do not meet the above specifications will not be
hung. *Please label the back of each piece of
artwork with name, phone, title of work, medium,
and price.*

FEES: \$8.00 per work
(checks payable to Arvada Fine Arts Guild)

AWARDS:

Best of Show: \$100 Echter's Gift Certificate
Echter's Choice: \$50 Echter's Gift Certificate
8 Merit Awards: \$25 each (awarded by AFAG)

SALES: Sales will be handled by Echter's staff;
all sales will go through Arvada Fine Arts Guild's
books for processing and tax reporting. A 15%
commission will be paid to Echter's. It is preferred
that sold works remain on display until the close of
the show.
