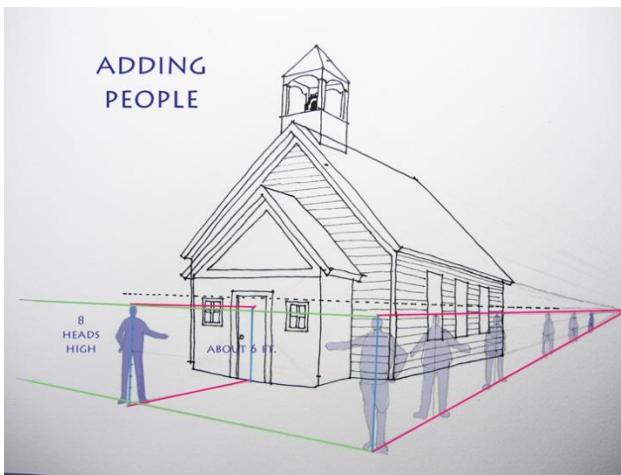

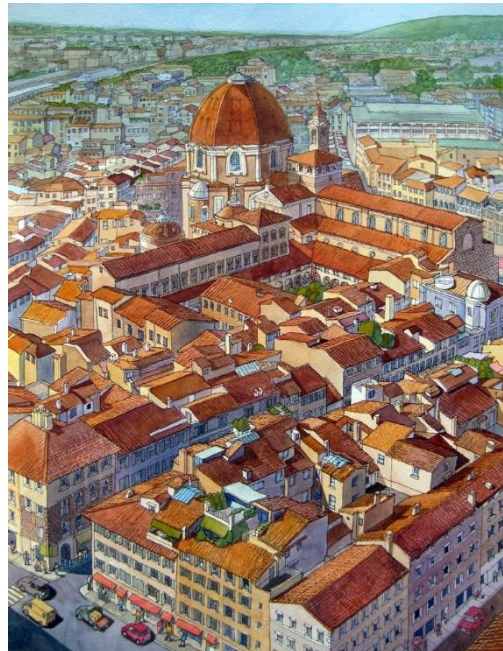
November Program



Jeremy Jones, an award-winning watercolorist and retired architect, will be presenting a more understandable way for artists to use accurate perspective in their artwork. While doing several thousand design drawings in his career, he developed simpler ways to understand what perspective is, what its limitations are, and how to use it to set up a sketch for

drawing or painting. For example, do you really know how to draw a wagon wheel using a circle in perspective and equally add 16 spokes spaced just right? How about adding a stairway to a building? Once you know what perspective really is, you can do one- and two-point perspective with less guessing.

You'll even get a peek at circular perspective.
